## Tasting Notes

Brooding aromas of blackberry preserves laced with brown sugar and baking spices, with hints of new leather, violets and wet stone. A generous forepalate of dark brambly fruit with exotic spice and a dense mouthfeel lead to refined but big, chewy tannins and a very long finish.

Vineyard: Red Heaven

Varieties: 69% Syrah and 31% Petite Sirah, co-fermented

Harvest Date: 9/20/2015

Winemaking: Cold soak, BM 4X4 yeast, extended maceration, natural malolactic fermentation

Oak: 21 months in 24% New French Oak (Dargaud & Jaegle Vosges Puncheon, medium toast) and 76% Neutral French Oak

Bottling: Unfined and unfiltered

Alcohol: 15.5%

pH: 4.07

Total Acidity: 5.2 g/l
