



CLAUDIO - SANGRIA

Grape variety(ies): Red wine, water, sugar, natural aromas.

Origin: The base wines come from the Mediterranean coast, mainly from Cyprus. They come from warm vineyards, producing wines with high alcoholic contents.

Soil: Often rich, deep, sandy-surface soils.

Vinification: The base wine are made following the traditional process, with a few day's vatting followed by the pressing. Blending of the aromas, sugar and water, before the bottling.

Tasting notes:

- **Color:** Medium intensity, red, bright.
- **Nose:** Citrus : orange, lemon, with spicy notes.
- **Palate:** Good sweetness, fresh, supple and round.

Recommendations: Serve cold, possibly with slices of orange or lemon.

Serving condition in F°: 42 - 46

Cellar potential: 1 year
